During the 5-day program, students will stay at a Pacific Northwest tribal community and will participate in field education, recreational outdoor activities, field trips, traditional methods of education, and classroom instruction. This is tentative scheduled for August 6-10, 2018. The Summer Youth Practicum is open to incoming 10<sup>th</sup> grade to 12<sup>th</sup> grade Native American high school students who are interested in the preservation, protection, and enhancement of Tribal Natural Resources.
