The Native American Fish & Wildlife Society requests paper submissions for its 35th Annual National Conference to be held in Rapid City, SD at the Ramkota Inn. The theme for this year's conference will focus on Climate Change. As with our conferences, the theme is intended to highlight the good work in natural resources and keeping in mind our future generations. Our focus is meant to be inclusive of all work by/or on behalf of Tribes, acknowledging the value of Traditional Tribal Knowledge and modern cutting-edge science. We want to see how Tribes are incorporating these areas in present day management and if preparing to pass this responsibility and philosophy on to future generations. Paper submissions from all areas of natural resource management are welcome with consideration given to submissions focusing on climate change, invasive species, and emerging fish and wildlife areas. In addition, we are asking for presentations and programs that are addressing youth development and empowerment. Submissions will be divided for presentations according to topic.
