Letters of Recommendation: 1 LOR must be either from academia (i.e. college faculty, advisor, teacher) OR Tribal relations (i.e. Tribal liaison, Faculty in Native American studies, Tribally employed person(s), director of the Native Cultural Center).

This specific scoring will help determine the applicant's character, goals/passions, work ethic, leadership, involvement and qualifications through the discussion and insight given in the letter of recommendation. Points are for each LOR, there are two letters of recommendation.
