- 10th - 12th Grade (ages 13 - 17) Students
- Enrolled or descendant of U.S. federally-recognized Tribe or Alaska Village
- Willing to possibly travel (fly on plane) alone
- Complete application packet

HOW TO APPLY:



- Applications OPEN Late March to Early April
- Application Components:
 - General Application
 - Creative Submission
 - Letter of Recommendation
 - Health, Liability, Media Waivers & Forms
 - Parent & Student Contract
