Forest Manager

Forestry Department, Regular, Full-time, Salary: \$80,945.03-\$88,528.39/Annually. Under the general supervision of the Tribal Chairman, the Forest Manager is responsible for the overall operations and overseeing all aspects of the Forestry Department. This position is located on the Hoopa Valley Indian Reservation where the incumbent is responsible for the completion of preparations required prior to offering timber for sale. Works with federal, state, and local agencies (NRCS, BLM, and USFS), the marketing committee selling of timber, and the riparian committee on fishery, environmental, and water quality issues.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Expertise in environmental document writing and familiarity with the N.E.P.A. process.
- Must be able to communicate effectively verbally and in written form.
- Expertise in budget preparation, report, and proposal writing.
- Must be familiar with overall forest management.
- Must have knowledge of harvesting methods.
- Knowledge of heavy equipment operation and use is desirable.
- MUST possess a Certified Timber Sale Forester Certificate. Must possess a Bachelor's degree from an accredited four-year college or university, in forestry or related field. Must have three or more years' experience in a management position, which must include supervising personnel.
